## Instructions for Creating Art Doll ATC's with Movable Body Parts

To create the Artist Trading Card art dolls described in these instructions, you'll need the print sheet that comes in this kit, a computer, printer, and sheet of cardstock. You'll also require a hole punch and mini-brads or eyelets that will allow for body parts to move. It usually takes no more than 4 brads per ATC doll.

1. Print the art doll page on 8 ½" x 11" size cardstock, allow for ½" margins or less on all four sides.
2. If you want to add color and design to any of the body parts, it's best to do it now.
3. Cut out ATC backing and doll pieces.

**Tip:** Before you assemble your doll, check to make sure the placement you want will allow for all the body pieces to slide inward so that the entire project is no larger than the size of an ATC card; (2 ½" x 3 ½").

4. After testing the parts for size and proper movement, use a pencil to lightly mark where you need to place your holes for the brads.



**Tip:** Use the least amount of brads you can get by with to keep the bulk down and to give yourself more options for body part movements. Usually fewer brads means you don't have as many challenges to deal with when rotating body parts to fit within the ATC size requirements.

**Note:** See attached diagrams for examples of where you might consider placing your brads so body parts will still fit inside the ATC.

5. Test the body parts one more time to make sure that each one can move around the others and still fit properly. Then punch the holes and attach the body parts using the mini-brads.
6. Add any additional embellishments you want on your card.

**Tip:** You can add another piece of cardstock or decorative paper to the back of your finished card to hide the brad tongs on the underside.

**REMEMBER:** Sign and date your ATC and be sure to show off your creation to our friends at CHW too. Maybe you can even work an ATC trade with someone!
